

Program for English Learners and English Language Learner (ELL) Services

Fiddlehead School of Arts and Sciences shall provide appropriate programs for English learners to assure equal educational opportunity. The program will assist students in attaining English proficiency and meeting state and local academic achievement standards in compliance with applicable federal and state requirements. Fiddlehead School of Arts and Sciences shall also provide opportunities for parent involvement in their children's education as required by federal law.

The Executive Director is responsible for developing and implementing the school unit's Lau Plan to meet the needs of English learners and any necessary administrative procedures, including procedures for identification, assessment, programming and monitoring. A Language Assessment Committee shall be appointed to assist in the coordination, oversight and periodic review of the program. The Executive Director may delegate specific responsibilities to building administrators or others as he/she deems appropriate.
